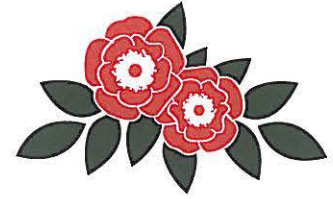

## Memorial lecture takes Churchill as theme

The University of Central Lancashire is opening its doors to the public on Thursday 14 February for the annual Tim Curtis Memorial Lecture.

This year's lecture, *Churchill and 'the enemy within': his struggles with internal 'red perils'* will be given by Professor Chris Wrigley, from the University of Nottingham.

The lectures are given in memory of Tim Curtis, a former Deputy Director of the University, who died of Leukaemia and who was passionate about extending access to higher education to people who may have missed their chance first time round.
