THE YA YA'S

The observant among you may recognise the name in connection with a certain popular band from Manchester whose name begins with O. When OASIS needed a bass player to fill in for the exhausted Guigsy a couple of years ago, they turned to their friends the YA YA'S, who take their musical inspiration from many of the same sources. Their demo's bring to mind classic groups like The Who, The Beatles, and T. Rex, with that vital up-to-date energy which gives their songs a contemporary feel. It's much the same ingredients that gives Oasis their edge over the other guitar bands around them at the moment, and the YA YA'S have certainly got the pop songs to compete on equal terms with their old mates, and perhaps a tendency towards more adventurous songwriting at times too, which has so far been Oasis' only flaw. They recently released a new single, "Like A Stone"/"A Night To Know" which demonstrates finely their ability to write well-crafted catchy tunes that stay in your head after one listen. Club Deluxe favourites, they've played twice before to a full house each time, so be early and be prepared to get pretty hot too. It's gonna be a scorcher of a gig.

Formed in Preston a couple of years ago, TCR have been going from strength to strength over the past year on the North West gig circuit, building up good followings in the Liverpool & Manchester areas, with some excellent shows that have seen them compared to the likes of The Verve, Charlatans, and early Rolling Stones. They certainly have the energy on stage to live up to such lofty comparisons, and are improving musically in leaps and bounds every time they play, with the new material being their best yet.
