Creative and radical solutions are key to ensure future carbon neutrality and family wellbeing at the heart of local communities. But the solutions are complex, and if delivered conventionally may have the effect of alienating local stakeholder audiences. For stakeholder engagement, experts must make a point of exercising and advancing verbal, graphical and pedagogic communication skills that enthuse and inspire communities. The 'City-zen' Smart City project has developed the 'Roadshow' methodology and engaged in one-week live, co-creation initiatives in several cities, meeting the challenge of delivering sustainability expertise locally.
