AIR RAID PRECAUTIONS

Each night the staff are to see that all window blinds, both upstairs and down, are drawn in their respective quarters at "Black Out" time.

The children's baths are to be half filled with cold water each night.

Day clothes must be kept handy at night-time.

Each child must have his or her Gas Mask available day and night. During the day-time the Masks must be kept downstairs, and at night placed under each bed as the children retire.

In the event of an "Air Raid Alarm" the girls with Sister Bond and Cook are to proceed to the Cottage cellar, using the Cottage back stairs, and the boys with Sister WILLIAMS stairs. The children must take their day clothes with them and dress in the cellars. Slippers to be worn.

Everyone must remain in the cellars until the "All Clear" signal is given, wim unless told by Mr. Slater or Matron to leave.

Cast-off Clothes, Shoes, Books, Periodicals, Tracts, etc., will be of great service, and thankfully received.
