Performance Directions

This piece is written for semi-improvised clarinet in Bb and electronics.

There are three different electronic materials which guide the performer to select the appropriate "trama"*. You can play this in full or choose any part of it (you can also repeat the same part or play the whole "trama" in full several times). You don't need to finish each "trama" – although you can if you wish to, and you have time. Perform the changes between "tramas" and the end of the piece smoothly.

These are the 3 different "tramas":

Trama 1: This appears at the start and the end of the piece – it is the only of them appearing twice. The electronic material is made of water drops.

Trama 2: This is made of slow and water flow.

Trama 3: This is made from sounds of fast flowing water and human voices (towards the end of it)

The structure of the piece is:

Trama 1 (0:00 to 1:29) **– Trama 2** (1:29 to c.3:44) **– Trama 3** (c.3:44 to c.5:05) **– Trama 1** (c.5:05 to end)

Performer should respond to each of them using the material from the score while listening to the electronics, working on the mixture of both textures (the one from the electronics and the one from the clarinet).

Techniques





short percussive sounds made by the keys - always indefinite pitch.



note accompanied by the consonant **t**.








Unpitched air accompanied by consonant **s**.







Note + voice. Diamond-shape notes show the pitch to be hummed by the performer – as the full score, this is transposed.

*In Spanish, "trama" means fabric's texture – and plot.
